Maintenance

Stardot recently repaired some of our outdoor lights and has ordered replacement parts for the remaining non-operational lights. We are hoping the repairs can be completed by the end of March.

Advantage Landscaping provided a detailed proposal for 2009 work along with the associated cost. A handout was provided. A few suggested changes will be made prior to seasonal work.

The number of treatments needed for the lake will be validated with our marine biologist.

Improvements

Planned improvements have started for the Woodbine entrance. Len is working with Growing Grounds to provide ideas for trees located at the entrance. The trees will be planted this year.

Colored fountain light covers are feasible. The board approved and will have installed prior to setting the fountains in the lake.

Companies were contacted to provide proposals on the geese post and fencing options. Options will be brought to the April board meeting.

Operations / Issues

John contacted the Bloomington Police Department pertaining to the Neighborhood Watch program. He gathered initial information and sent to board members. Two homeowners volunteered to help with the program.

John was added to the Directors and Officers liability portion of our insurance policy.
